The workshop is open to all public safety dive teams, military divers, diving professionals and dealers.

Workshop Program

Pre-registration with DUI is required. While last minute additions are possible, we must have a good idea of attendance so we have enough program materials. Attendees may be divided into two groups depending on experience level so we can best address the interests of a varied group. The program will include:

- A discussion defining contaminated water diving and the difficulties in evaluating those conditions
- An overview of the US Navy, Association of Diving Contractors, and OSHA standards that include contaminated water diving/decontamination procedures directly applicable to public safety operations.
- A discussion on the pros and cons of different drysuit materials for public safety diver use.
- Special concerns for public safety diving ops and the unique features of DUI products that address those needs.
- **NEW!** Hands on demonstrations of decontamination procedures including definitive decontamination. These hands on demos will include the set up of a rapid deployment decon shower and pool as well as the demonstration of the Macaw Compressed Air Foam System which is designed to provide definitive decontamination for biological contamination and can be used to make a barrier against surface fuel.
- Demo of all DUI products including suits with DUI ZipSeals and the RS1050 vulcanized rubber drysuit
- At many locations, demo SubSalve lift bags specially designed for public safety diving, including a display of their VRS-2000 Vehicle Recovery System. Divers Alert Network (DAN) will be on hand at selected events to provide details about DAN's support of PSD ops, including their new "Diving First Aid for Professional Divers", designed specifically to bring together an array of training disciplines into one complete course; saving you time and increasing your team capabilities.
